

PROFESSOR ELLIOT SMITH'S LECTURES.

No more interesting course of lectures has yet been arranged under the auspices of the University Extension Board than the lectures which Professor Grafton Elliot Smith is to deliver on "Ancient Egypt and the Dawn of Civilisation" in the Great Hall of the University. The first of these lectures, tickets for which may be procured at Angus and Robertson's, will be given on Tuesday evening next, the subject being "The Prehistoric Egyptians." In subsequent lectures Professor Elliot Smith, who is recognised as one of the world's greatest Egyptologists, will deal with the following subjects:—"The History of Mummification" (Thursday, July 23); "Ancient Tombs and Temples" (Tuesday, July 28); and "The Influence of Ancient Egypt on the History of Civilisation" (Thursday, July 30).
